- Input from County Technical Team at departmental level (CCOs & Directors)
- Public Participation on Draft Policy during the PPFs for the FY 2019/20 ADP.
- Approval by the CEC in July, 2019
- Publishing and Publicizing in July, 2019
- Sensitization on the M&E Policy:
 - Directors and CCOs on 03.09.2019
 - Administrators on 05.03.2020
 - Office of the Governor, CECMs and CCOs on 10.03.2020
 - National Gov't MDAs on 11.03.2020




M&E Unit



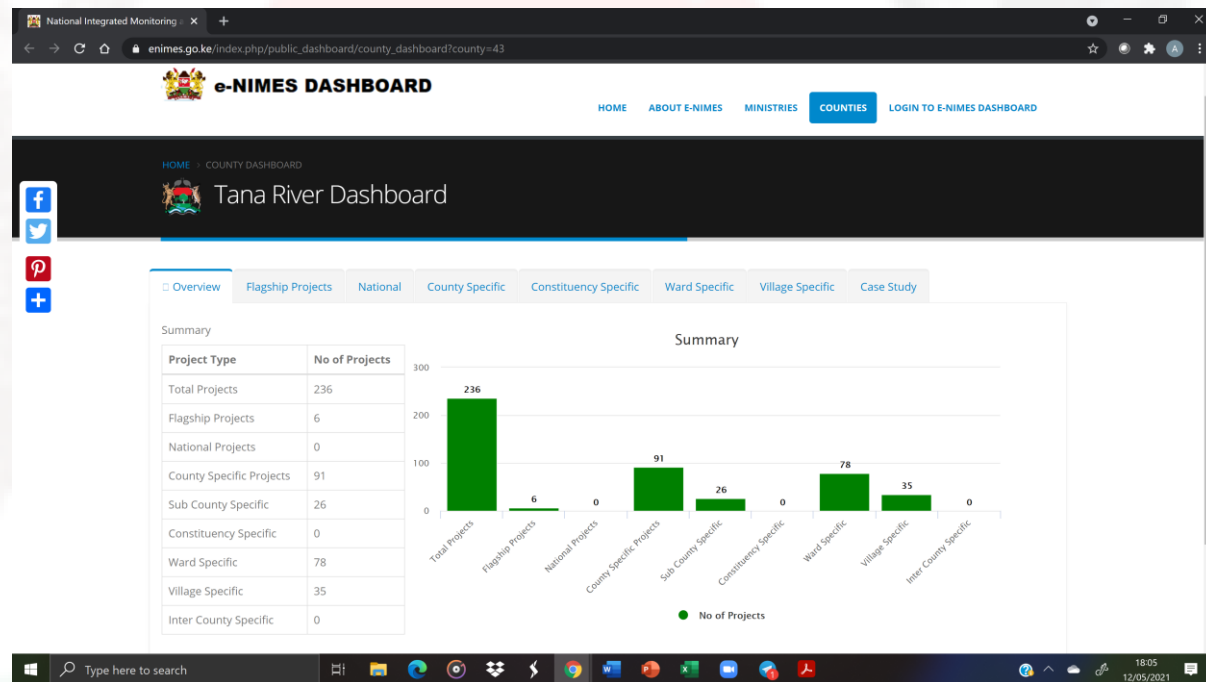

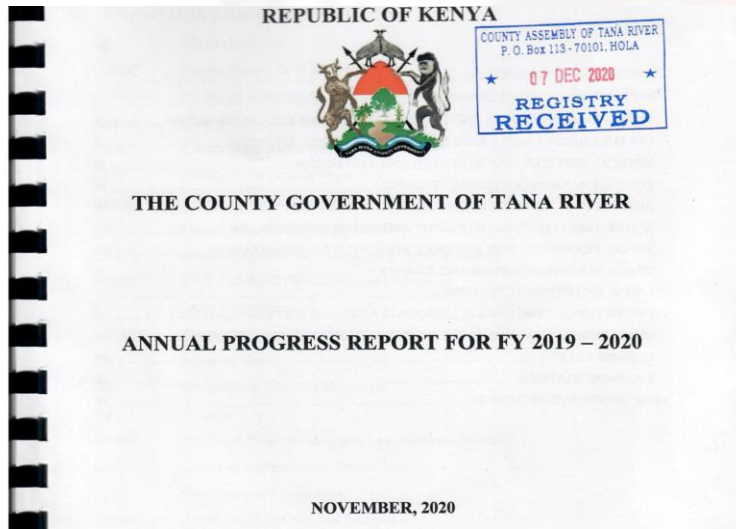
