- West Pokot County is one of the Counties in the Rift Valley region.
- Size **9,169.4 km²** .
- Population **621,241**.
- Poverty **57.3%**

M&E situation

- **M&E unit** domicile at Finance and Economic Planning.
- **M&E focal** person at department level to link with M&E unit
- Governors Delivery Unit(**GDU**)

Challenges affecting M&E Operations

- Inadequate **financial resources** to M&E
- **Weak M&E** in departments.
- Inadequate **M&E personnel** in department.
- Limited **baseline data**.
- **Low** use of M&E reports in decision making.

For Effective M&E operation

- Support **functioning of CIMES structures.**
- Adequate **budget allocation** to M&E functions.
- **Capacity building** of departments on M&E.
- Enhance stakeholder **feedback** and **dissemination** forums;

Opportunities during and post COVID-19 Pandemic crisis

- **Technologies** -Leverage use of ICT
- **Business opportunities** -
(preparation of mask/sanitizers)
- Research/training.
